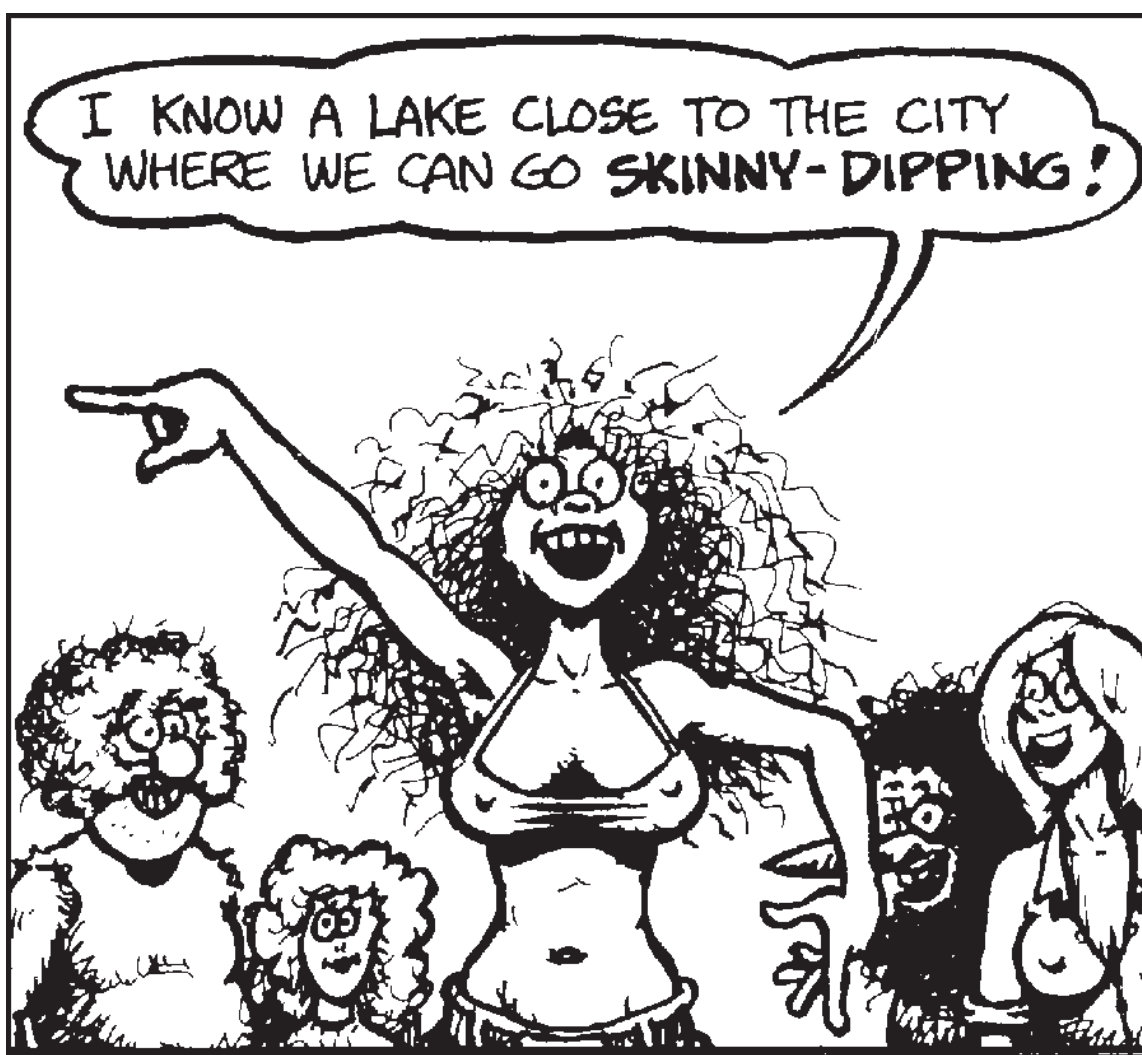

Important: If you live outside the US, please see our Foreign Customers Information page (<http://www.ripoffpress.com/foreign.cfm>) or request a printed copy of the information on it, before ordering.

PLACING YOUR ORDER

Sorry, we do not ship C.O.D.!

Besides US checks or money orders, we accept **Visa, Mastercard, or American Express**. If **mailing in your order** you can use any sheet of paper. Start by writing your **name, shipping address, e-mail and /or telephone number**. You must be **over 18 years of age** and sign a statement to that effect, in order to order items with an **asterisk (*)** after the title in the catalog. After filling in the above information:

1. Write the **description** (including ISSUE NUMBER on comix, SIZE on tee shirts), **price, quantity and total cost** for each item ordered. To avoid credit memos on **out-of-stock items** when paying by check or money order, you may specify **alternate selections**. If you're ordering one or more posters and don't want them sent folded, don't forget to order a **poster tube**. They cost \$3 and you only need one per order.
2. Use a calculator to add up the **merchandise total**, and write it down.
3. Add **8^{1/4}% sales tax** on the merchandise total, **only** if you live in California (new rate effective 4/1/09).
4. Add the charge for **postage and handling** for the amount of your merchandise total (see the chart below). If you are reordering an item that was out of stock from a previous order, the P&H charge is still required.
5. If you have a **gift certificate, credit memo or discount certificate**, subtract it. Enclose your **original copy of the credit memo/certificate**.
6. If you have a **balance due** from a previous order, add it.
7. Total the items in 2 through 6. This is your **Grand Total**. Enclose check (made out to Rip Off Press) or money order in this amount and mail it with your order, or write down your Visa, Mastercard, Discover or AmEx account information (including the expiration date and your billing name & address, if different from "Ship to") to charge to your charge card (don't forget to sign it).

If **phoning in your order** (Charged to one of the aforementioned cards only): Call **530 885-8183**. Have your want list and your charge card handy. We'll take it from there. We are usually available to answer the phone in person from 6:30 to noon and 5 p.m. to 10 p.m. Pacific time, Monday through Friday. Weekend hours vary. You can also send us an order by email (mail@ripoffpress.com) and pay for it by Paypal.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF ORDER PROBLEMS

If there is any problem with your order, probably the quickest and most effective way to deal with it is to send us an **e-mail**. That way you can get through to us at your convenience, and we will see your message within a few hours at a time when we have access to all of our records. Our e-mail address is **mail@ripoffpress.com**. If you're not yet one of the millions of people with access to e-mail, you can call us by **phone**. Please call **530 885-8183**. If we're not there to answer your call you can usually leave a message on our answering machine. You may also notify us of order problems by **letter (P.O. Box 4686, Auburn CA 95604-4686)**.

Possible problem situations:

Nondelivery:

If your order has **not arrived within two weeks** of the time you placed it (allow **3 weeks** for processing time plus air delivery **overseas**), please advise us of the date your order was placed and what you ordered. If you have a cancelled check or your charge account was billed, please tell us the date of deposit. We may be unable to trace orders shipped longer than 6 months previously, so don't wait too long to report a missing order!

Shipping Damage:

Please notify us of the date of delivery, your invoice number and what item(s) were damaged. Please hold onto the damaged merchandise in case the Post Office needs to see it. We'll notify you of what's being done.

Mis-Ships:

If your order arrives with **incorrect, missing or factory reject** items please tell us your invoice number and what the problem is. We'll advise you what we're going to do to fix the problem. If we want you to return a misshipped item we will furnish you with a postpaid envelope.

Returns Policy

If you change your mind about items you've ordered after receiving them, we will accept returns on items other than video and audio tapes, and CD's. Please note that returns on video and audio tapes and CD's are limited to replacing a defective copy with another copy of the same title. For this reason, please order these items with care and make sure that the title you order is what you really want! For other items, contact us (email preferred: mail@ripoffpress.com) to receive an OK for return first. Returns should be sent to us postpaid and packed carefully to arrive in salable condition. A copy of your original invoice for the purchase of the returned item(s) should be enclosed. Your account will be credited for the merchandise total of returned items less a 15% reshelving fee. Please note that we extend this service as a courtesy to our customers, and that returns cost us money. As a Mom 'n' Pop company we hope that return privileges will not be abused.

Poster tubes sent outside the U.S. incur a US\$20 postage surcharge due to shape-based postal rates.

PUBLISHER'S OVERLAY PROOFS

Before most of our comix titles were printed, either the printer or the company which created the film color separations (from which the plates were made for printing the color covers of the comix) provided us with a color proof so that we could make sure the color would look OK before we went to press. These were usually the overlay type, in which clear films with an emulsion the same color as the four process colors of printer's ink are exposed to the actual separation negatives and put together to simulate the final printed appearance. They tend to be very bright and shiny looking, and have more dimensionality than an actual comic cover since they are made up of several different layers.

For the vast majority of our publications there has only ever been one POP made, the one which was created when the title was first sent to press. This makes them much rarer than animation cels, since even on comic titles that sold tens of thousands of copies there was only one single POP-not thousands as there are cels that go to make up an animated film. Over the years we have amassed quite a few of these, and we are now offering some of them as art collectibles. Many of them represent the entire comic cover exactly as it was printed, while others are images of the artist's original cover painting only and do not include the text which was added mechanically giving the cover price, publisher's logo and other information.

Each POP is accompanied by a Certificate of Authenticity from Rip Off Press, certifying that this POP is the one and only original made as part of the process of publishing the title in question. Individual POP prices reflect the popularity of the artist or title, condition and appearance of the POP, and size. Most comic cover POP's are approximately 7" by 10" with some additional border, whereas magazine size is 8 1/2" by 11" plus border and wraps are 10" by 14".

RIP OFF COMIX

The original Rip Off Comix series began in the mid-1970's as a vehicle for the comix produced by the Rip Off Comics Syndicate. It ceased publication following issue 12 in 1983.
